Due to the situation with the COVID-19 pandemic the project’s board is now considering the possibility of holding the conference in the online mode.

TOPICS OF THE FINAL CONFERENCE:

- ICT-based educational technology;
- active and interactive learning and innovative teaching methods in higher education;
- theory and practice in online education, e- and b-learning;
- course- and content-design in higher education.

It is planned to publish a collection of project materials including articles before the conference. The publication is free of charge. The articles submitted by the authors will get through a preliminary review.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLISHING ARTICLES in the Final Conference’s Proceedings

Size of the article is between 4 and 6 pages, A4 format (210 x 297 mm.)

Requirements for the text:

- word processor is MS Word,
- font is Times New Roman, size – 14 pt.

Formulas and symbols are typed using the built-in editor MS Word text editor formulas.

Margins: top margin is 35 mm, on the right is 20 mm, on the left is 20 mm, foot margin is 25 mm.

Paragraph indentation is 1 cm. (indentation of spaces is prohibited).

Line spacing is single.

Each of the lines below is indented, left justified:

- author's name and surname (bold type, capitals);
- full name of the institution, city, country;
- name of the article (bold type, capitals).

The text is placed after skipping a line with indentation with obligatory alignment in width.

It is allowed to structure the article into chapters.

Tables and figures should have a name. The font in them must be at least 12 pt.

Figures and tables not exceeding the above page parameters are not allowed.

An example of figures' and tables' name:

Figure 1 – Student's educational activity model

Table 1 – The total content of compounds

At the end of the article, you must provide a list of sources used:

- empty line;
- words «LIST OF REFERENCES»;
- further in the order of references in the text, information is given about each source with indentation. Sources are indicated in the international APA format. Detailed information on using the format can be found on the website:
