

Organization board invites you to take part in the International scientific and practical conference “Digital environment: technologies and perspectives», which takes place at October 29–30, 2026 in Brest, held by the “Brest state technical university” educational institution.

The conference topics

1. Intellectual technologies of data processing and prediction, analysis and modeling of complex systems and physical processes.
2. Electronic components of cyber-physical systems, embedded systems, computer vision, and biometric technologies.
3. Innovative ways of the information content representation, electronic information technologies in distant learning and learning management systems.
4. Development of system software and applications, open-source systems.
5. Technologies and means of human-computer interaction.
6. Systems of data parallel processing, transfer and storage, distributed data processing, quantum computing.
7. Technologies of virtualization, cloud systems infrastructure, information security and implementation of the highly available network applications.

Working languages of the conference are Russian, Belarussian, and English.

Following ways of participation are proposed:

- plenary/keynote talk;
- session/thread talk.

Timing: plenary talk – up to 30 minutes, session talk – up to 15 minutes

Participation requirements

To take part in the conference, please provide the following materials to the organization board not later than **September 14, 2026:**

- 1) paper on the topic of your talk in either OpenDocument (.ODT), Microsoft Word 97–2003 (.DOC) or Microsoft Word 2007–365 (.DOCX) format (use first author’s surname as a part of the file name);
- 2) participation request, filled along the proposed form.

Participation requests and papers should be submitted via the Open Journal Systems submit and review platform, via the following link: <https://journal.bstu.by/detp2026>.

The talk is included into the conference program based on peer-review of the submitted materials.

The conference has mixed participation format, which includes either in-person talk or talk via videoconferencing.

Participation in the conference is free of charge.

Proceeding book will be published after the conference, with registration in the RINC scientometric database.

Travel, food expenses and hotel are paid by participants by their own or by their sending organizations.

Formatting guidelines

- The recommended size of the materials varies from 3 to 6 pages of the A5 format.
- The font is Times New Roman, 10pt, single line spacing, with 5 mm indent.
- Margins: 15mm left and right, 15mm top, and 15mm bottom.
- The first line contains the UDC code.
- The second line contains the title of the paper in capital letters.
- Next comes the authors' last name and initials (the speaker's last name should be underlined);
- The names block is followed by contact information: full name of the organization, city, country, and email address.
- Next comes the abstract in English, separated by a blank line. The recommended length of the abstract is up to 500 characters..
- Next follows the text of the materials, separated by a blank line.
- Figures should be placed in text with appropriate captions, and also submitted in separate files in the following formats: PDF, SVG, PNG or JPG; schemes and diagrams are preferable in vector formats (PDF, SVG), photos are better submitted in raster ones (PNG, JPG).
- Tables should be placed in text and should have numbering.
- After an empty line there should be the «REFERENCES» title (indented, left-aligned) followed by the list of references in an order of their mentioning. Each reference should have indentation and follow the GOST 7.1-2003 style. Literature should be referenced in text in square brackets.
